



Who are we?

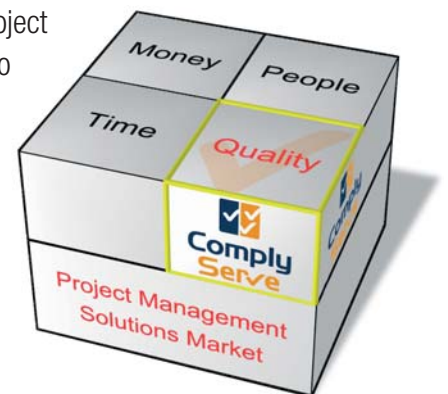
